



## **Role of School Sport Co-ordinator (SSCo)**

The position is for an existing secondary school teacher (QTS) or NQT to undertake a full time role of secondary teacher (2 days) and SSSCo role (3 days) across eleven schools in the Tees Valley area. Responsible for the co-ordination and development of inter school competition, festival delivery, CPD and local community links in the primary schools.

### Overall role

- Co-ordination of school sport within a cluster of schools
- Ensure effective implementation of the cluster development plan
- Ensure that the cluster development plan complements and enhances school physical education programmes and school development plans in the secondary and primary schools.
- Ensure that ALL young people are included in the clusters physical education and sport programme.

### Specific functions

1. To co-ordinate the planning of school sport across the family of schools, actively involving local sports organisations
2. To monitor and evaluate the progress in relation to the development plan and contribute to the partnership monitoring & evaluation process
3. To support Primary Link Teachers in developing school sport in their school
4. To develop and implement out of school hours learning programmes across the group of schools
5. To increase and improve the range of intra and inter school sporting competition in the primary schools.
6. To engage and involve more young people in community sport
7. To promote the benefits and successes of the cluster work and ensure it has a high profile.
