



Brambles Primary Academy Background Information



At Brambles Primary Academy, our motto is simply 'Learning together; growing together; making a difference'. This embodies our belief that, as part of the Tees Valley Education Trust, we aim to develop a community of learners who through the dynamic teaching and learning, committed collaboration and consistent drive for progress, all achieve their full potential. We intend to recruit staff of the highest quality so we are able to consolidate, challenge and constantly improve the quality of the education we provide for the 300 children on roll, including our 2-4 year old provision.



We are very proud of our Trust and our school and are delighted to serve the community of Brambles Farm in East Middlesbrough. As a Trust, we are on an incredibly exciting journey with our partner schools Pennyman Primary Academy and Dormanstown Academy, to work

collaboratively to ensure the best outcomes for all of our learners and staff. Whilst our context is challenging (around 25% of children have Special Educational Needs and 76% of our pupils are eligible for free school meals) we believe it is our responsibility to support our children in their life chances, opportunities and employability. The academy consists of 3 phases: Early Years Foundation Stage, Key Stage 1 and Key



Stage 2. Each year group is 2 form entry, with an admission number of 45 per year. Within each year group there are Learning Support Assistants to meet the varying needs of all our children. Our inclusive ethos and well-established system of pastoral care allows us to integrate our children as much as possible, and has created a nurturing environment that enables children to be successful, confident learners.

Our Academy has been recognised by Ofsted (June 2014) as providing an outstanding education for all pupils. They reported that through consistently high expectations, outstanding teaching and an exceptional wide range of opportunities available, pupils achieve exceptionally well academically, personally, physically and creatively. Good relationships between staff and pupils combined with excellent behaviour, develop children who are confident and polite young people, eager to learn and are very proud of their academy.



We, too, are incredibly proud of our achievements at Brambles and the opportunities offered to everyone within our academy. We are dedicated to making a difference to the lives of the children in our care. Consequently, we are looking for talented, dynamic and committed individuals to join and contribute to our hard-working team.
