- To carry out minor building works associated with the main duties of this post.
- To deliver a service in accordance with the company's procedures, Service Charter
 & Code of Practice and all relevant legislation and British Standards.
- To carry out all work requested via the company's communication systems, which may include; PDA, tablet devices, telecommunication and IT systems.
- To carry out, if required and appropriate, any repair to a gas, sanitary or heating appliance, plumbing or heating system identified whilst already undertaking work in the property.
- To accurately record all work activity carried out and the materials used.
- To ensure that all documentation is promptly returned upon completion for all jobs to the team leader.
- Responsible for their own compliance to Health & Safety legislation, safe systems
 of work and for the safety of any other persons who may be affected by the work
 being carried out.
