POST TITLE: On-Road Cycle Instructor - Casual

GRADE: Band 4

RESPONSIBLE TO: Road Safety Officer

RESPONSIBLE FOR: Delivery of Bikeability

Overall Objectives of the Post:

To support the Road Safety Section in delivering Bikeability Level 1 and 2 to pupils in Years 4,5 and 6 in all of the Primary schools across the Council.

Key Tasks of the Post:

1. You will achieve these objects by:

- Helping young cyclists to become confident and safe.
- Assisting with the development of the programme and the delivery of training, ensuring that it is carried out to the set criteria.
- Assessing the progress of the trainees.
- Ensuring the safety of the trainees at all times by carrying out a risk assessment of the site prior to the children being taken out on the road.
- Ensuring compliance with all of the Council's health and safety policies and procedures.
- 2. You will be an effective member of the Road Safety Team and contribute positively to the team working by:
 - Working in a positive and co-operative manner with other members of the team.
 - Being highly self motivated and skilled.
 - Contributing in a positive and effective manner to team and service initiatives.

3. You will contribute positively to the continuous improvement of the Council's Road safety team by:

- Contributing in the successful implementation of Best Value improvements, the Investors In People initiative, Council Performance Assessment, County Strategy and Performing Together Strategy.
- Taking part in training programmes as required.
- Developing your knowledge and experience and keeping up to date, by keeping abreast of new initiatives and changes in legislation.
