What is a Pre Apprenticeship?

Newcastle City Council offer Pre Apprenticeships that can last for a period of 12 weeks to 1 Year. The purpose of this is to allow you as an individual to experience the occupation and placement practices that you would encounter when undertaking an apprenticeship. It also allows the placement staff to assess your suitability for the role. If you then decide this is the occupation you would like to choose as your career path then you would be able to apply to move onto the Level of apprenticeship available for that occupation. We cannot however guarantee that all pre apprentices would be able to move onto an apprenticeship. During your placement with us we would ensure that you have gained valuable real work experience that would enhance your career prospects. Entry requirements for pre apprenticeships are dependant on the occupational area and can range from no educational qualifications to three GCSE's at grades A* to C including Maths and English or their equivalent. During the preapprenticeship you will be required to study towards gaining the relevant educational qualifications in Maths & English if you do not already have them.

The requirements for the pre apprenticeships on offer vary greatly from year to year. Newcastle City Council are looking to recruit a **Pre-apprentice Vehicle Mechanic** to work in our busy workshops.

How much will I earn?

You will be paid:

Under 18 £4.20 per hour

18 to 20 year old £5.90 per hour

21 to 24 year old £7.38 per hour

25+ years £7.83 per

You will be paid on the last working day of each month directly into your bank account.

What should I expect from a pre-apprenticeship at Newcastle City Council?

A Placement induction to help you understand your role and the council

A structured work programme placing you alongside experienced staff

Time from your working week to study towards recognised qualifications

Progress review meetings with your manager, mentor and training staff

Support to help you apply for jobs
