

School Information



St. Peter's School is a Church of England Primary School for children between the age of 2 and 11. The school is part of the Galileo Multi-Academy Trust which was formed on 1st April 2018. The trust currently has 8 Community and 2 Church of England Primary schools all situated within the borough of Redcar & Cleveland. We aim to provide exciting opportunities for both staff and pupils alike.

There are currently approximately 300 children attending the St. Peter's full-time, together with a 39-place Nursery, some of whom attend all day, and a 20-place prenursery group. The school also supports children with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities within two dedicated classes. The Infant Assessment Unit supports 12 children of 3 to 7 years and the Junior Support Base provides educational support for 15 KS2 pupils of 7 to 11 years. The School is also an associate member of the East Cleveland Co-operative Learning Trust.

St. Peter's School was built in 1972 on its current site to replace older premises in the village. It has a very attractive setting with extensive playing fields and grounds. The building is of a semi-open plan design which includes large teaching spaces and many opportunities for learning outside the classroom. Over the past years the school has had extensive remodelling to many of the teaching areas, both inside and out.

All staff work very hard to make the children feel safe, happy and confident to ensure that they make good academic progress. The school values greatly the support given by the parents and the community.

The School places a strong emphasis on learning outside the classroom and is a Green Flag Eco Ambassador School. Presentations at conferences, both locally and regionally, about Sustainable School activities have been given by pupils and staff as a leading school in this area.

The school has its own purpose built Sports and Arts Hall which opened in 2003. The building is used to support a range of activities including the PE and Arts curriculum, Breakfast Club and the school's extra curricular clubs. The facility includes showers, a community room, office and kitchen areas.

The Breakfast Club operates from 8.00am until 8.45am each day. At the end of each school day, beginning at 3.30pm, there is a range of activities for the pupils. These

take place either in the main building or in the Sports and Arts Hall and finish usually by 6.00pm.

We are deeply indebted to The Variety Club of Great Britain for providing us with two minibuses which allow us to take our children to many sporting activities and off-site educational visits.

The school also runs sports and arts courses during the holidays and all children in Key Stage 1 and 2 are offered the opportunity of residential visits to support their learning.

The school is very much part of the community and has particularly strong links with St. Margaret's Church. As a church school strong emphasis is placed on Christian teaching and this contributes naturally to the atmosphere of the school and the moral and spiritual development of the children. Parents are encouraged to visit the school frequently for school events, as well as for open evenings each term to discuss children's progress and on any occasion when they wish to have discussions with the staff. The school was assessed as outstanding in all areas of its most recent Church School Inspection report (April 2015).

When the children complete their education at St. Peter's School at the end of Year 6 they then transfer to local secondary schools. The school has developed close links with secondary schools both as part of the National Curriculum transition programmes and through extra curricular activities. The school has also developed close links with the neighbouring KTS Academy as part of our integration programme for those children with SEND.

It is the intention of all Staff and Governors of St. Peter's School to provide children with a sound education in a warm, caring and safe environment where pupils are encouraged to achieve to the highest levels in all areas of their experiences.
