Job Purpose Delivery of a variety of Road Safety Initiatives and Training

including, Pedestrian Training, Balance Bike Training and Bikeability Cycle Training at various locations and to different target groups across Newcastle following a pre-arranged

programme of delivery.

The Road Safety Instructors will ensure that courses and delivery comply with the relevant standards and the Council's

policies and procedures.

Main Duties: The following is typical of the duties the post holder will be expected to perform. It is not necessarily exhaustive and other duties of a similar nature and level may be required from time to time. The necessity to perform duties at a lower level of

responsibility is not precluded

- 1. To deliver Road Safety Training.
- 2. To ensure the safety of trainees and other road users at all times.
- 3. Attend internal and external training and meetings to keep up to date with developments in the delivery of Road Safety and Cycle training.
- 4. Ensure training records and paperwork are completed and returned at monthly team meetings.
- 5. To check that appropriate resources are available to support the delivery of various road safety programmes.
- 6. To undertake 'dynamic' risk assessments when delivering Road Safety Programmes.
- 7. To support Senior Instructors in promoting sessions to enhance the image and reputation of the Road Safety service and encourage the take up of training places for all programmes.

- 8. To assist in ensuring the standards and targets for all training are achieved.
- 9. To support schools to help them get the most out of the training.
- 10. To promote and implement the Council's Equality Policy in all aspects of employment and service delivery
- 11. To assist in maintaining a healthy, safe and secure environment and to act in accordance with the Council's policies and procedures.
