Main Duties and Responsibilities

- To support the Head Chef in the preparation of all meals to an excellent standard and to maintain standards of portion control
- To deputise for the Head Chef in the event of absence or training
- To assist the Head Chef in the procurement of stock and supplies
- To ensure that all equipment and work areas including the dining hall are maintained to a high standard of cleanliness, hygiene and safety practice
- To assist the Head Chef in the regularly review the menu using feedback obtained from any interested party
- To support the Head Chef with the management the catering team
- To ensure food services are running efficiently
- To encourage pupils to take an interest in food and promote healthy eating by educational activities
- To carry out other reasonable tasks from time to time as directed by the Heads of School
