Job Title: Teacher

Hours/week: Part time

Job Purpose:

The Teacher will:

- Take responsibility for teaching a mixed age (ks1 or ks2) class, and ensure that planning, preparation, recording, assessment and reporting meet pupils varying learning and social needs;
- maintain the positive ethos and core values of the school, both inside and outside the classroom;
- contribute to constructive team-building amongst teaching and non-teaching staff, parents and governors;
- ensure that the current national conditions of employment for schoolteachers are met.
- fulfil the role of DSL, with appropriate training and deputise for the lead DSL as required.

Duties:

In line with teacher standards the Teacher will:

- Plan and deliver an appropriate, broad, balanced, relevant, differentiated and challenging curriculum to all pupils appropriate to their needs
- Assess, record and report on all aspects of pupils' progress and development
- Be able to set clear targets, based on prior attainment, for pupils' learning
- Provide a stimulating classroom environment, where resources can be accessed appropriately by all pupils;
- Contribute to whole school planning activities
- Support initiatives decided by the Head Teacher and staff
- Implement agreed school policies and guidelines
- Report to parents on the development, progress and attainment of pupils;
- Maintain good order and discipline amongst pupils, in accordance with the school's behaviour policy;
- Communicate and co-operate with specialists from outside agencies;
- Lead, organise and direct support staff within the classroom;
- Mark the attendance registers
- Play a full part in the life of the school community and support its ethos, values and aims
- Comply with the schools Health and Safety policy and undertake risk assessments as appropriate
- Engage actively in Performance Management and Professional Development to ensure professional skills are developed and kept up to date
