Our bottom line is that we expect all students to succeed. There are many opportunities for budding writers to showcase their talents, including our brilliant Year 9 students who recently took part in a Newcastle University project working with real writers to produce stunning poetry and artwork now on display in galleries across the region.

From leading roles to stagehands, our annual shows bring the whole school together to entertain our community. Our performing arts department takes part in a National Theatre project where

students perform on the Northern Stage in Newcastle. Students can also access musical tuition and take part in orchestra and choir activities, including performing in the prestigious NELT concerts at the Sage Gateshead.

School trips

Activities further afield include our popular Year 7 outward bound residential to Dukehouse Wood, as well as cultural trips to London and South Africa, and curriculum linked visits to the Lake District, Zurich and Iceland. Every year, student take part in activities week which includes adventurous sports and fun days out.

Sports

Sport is important at Bedlington Academy with students' commitment and talent paying off with regular top ups of the silverware cabinet.

Community spirit

We have a strong connection with our local community and regularly support church and charity events. Every year we host an OAP Christmas Dinner and this year we are supporting St Oswald's Hospice's *Elmer's Great North Parade* with our own Bedlington Academy designed Elmer.

Building character

Students have their views heard as representatives on our student council or as prefects. Our Duke of Edinburgh's Award programme allows students to gain a nationally recognised qualification whilst completing expeditions and helping the local community and environment.

Students also have the opportunity to become a member of our Combined Cadet Force, one of only two in Northumberland.

Our students make excellent progress at GCSE and A level. In 2019 80% of A level students achieved or exceeded their target grade and our rate of Grade 9 results at GCSE was three times higher than last year.

NORTH EAST LEARNING TRUST

In April 2018, Bedlington Academy joined the North East Learning Trust, a highly successful multi-academy education Trust which spans the region.

The Trust's vision is simple and shared by all schools who join the family; that 'every child experiences excellence every day'.

The Trust's founding school, The Academy at Shotton Hall, has achieved great success for their children by securing some of the best outcomes in the country. In 2019 the school achieved some of the best GCSE results in County Durham and they have been awarded two consecutive outstanding judgments from Ofsted. They have also been designated as a national research school, one of just 23 in the country.

Shotton Hall is a National Teaching School training the next generation of teachers and ensuring the highest standards of teaching are instilled from the outset. This means the Trust can access a steady stream of consistently high quality staff to meet workforce needs across its schools.

Joining the Trust has given Bedlington Academy access to outstanding leaders who are involved in the regional and national development of education. The Trust CEO sits on the Regional Schools Commissioning Board and the CEO and Deputy CEOs are all National Leaders of Education.

Bedlington Academy also has access to a wide network of specialist teachers and other experienced professionals to support us on our road to outstanding.
