Job Purpose

To deliver cycle training to primary school children enabling children to cycle more safely and confidently.

The key roles of this post will include:

- 1. Deliver cycle training to groups of children to Bikeability standards
- 2. Work with and manage groups of children in a controlled, clear and calm manner
- 3. Manage and organise sessions at schools liaising with teaching and support staff
- 4. Support the Road Safety Officer with administration in organising and booking sessions and updating training records
- 5. Assist with other projects which aim to raise levels of cycling and walking
- 6. Gain if necessary and maintain Bikeability accreditation and other qualifications relevant to the post
- 7. Demonstrating cycling skills competently and confidently to children
- 8. Explaining the principles of safe cycling to children
- 9. Demonstrating good communication skills, understanding and empathy with children
- 10. Ensure health and safety and safeguarding principles are maintained
- 11. Transporting training equipment to sessions by car
- 12. To undertake other duties commensurate with the post grade.
