Essential

- Ability to complete basic paperwork which may include basic arithmetic
- Willingness to develop undertake job related training, for example risk assessments.
- Effective team worker
- Experience of working effectively with the general public
- Registered National Standard Bikeability Cycle Instructor

Desirable

- Be able to drive and have a car available for work.
