Job Title:	PE Apprentice

Focus:	 To work under the guidance of the class teacher in the planning and implementation of physical activity work programmes. 			
Generic responsibilities:	 Maintain personal expertise, to be a role model and promote high expectations for all members of the school community through your role within the structure. To model the values, ethos and vision of the Trust. To maintain at all times, the utmost confidentiality with regard to all records, personal data relating to staff, students and other information of a sensitive or confidential nature. 			
Specific responsibilities:	 Support the planning, delivery and evaluation of Sports, PE and Physical Activity to classes. Develop new sessions with existing school teachers. Support the development of extra-curricular activities such as lunch and after school clubs. Provide additional support to students who need it. To work closely and support the teacher with administrative tasks related to organisation of sporting events. To assist with the general pastoral care of students, including helping students who are unwell, distressed or unsettled. Escort and supervise students on educational and out of school activities. Acting as a teaching assistant for other classes. Prepare and present displays. 			
Special Conditions:	 The post-holder will be expected to undertake any appropriate training provided by the Trust to assist them in carrying out any of the above duties. The post-holder will be expected to contribute to the protection of children and vulnerable adults, as appropriate, in accordance with any agreed policies and/or guidelines, reporting any issues or concerns to their immediate line manager. The post-holder will be required to promote, monitor and maintain health, safety and security in the work place. To include ensuring that the requirements of Health & Safety at Work Act, COSHH, and all other mandatory regulations are adhered to. An Enhanced Disclosure with the Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) will be undertaken before and appointment can be confirmed.
