Internal Audit Practitioner Apprenticeship

Level: 4

Duration: 18 months

Training Provider: MBKB – Newcastle

It is envisaged that this training will be delivered in Newcastle by MBKB but may be delivered virtually.

Required learning commitments: 20% off the job learning (equivalent to 1 day per week) 80% on the job learning. This can include:

- taught sessions by the training provider
- role play
- coaching and mentoring
- simulation exercises
- online learning
- work shadowing
- self study and assignment completion

Knowledge and Skills to be covered include:

- Commercial Awareness
- Corporate Governance and Risk Management
- Organisations Business Processes
- Risk and Control / Audit Methodology
- Building Relationships
- Communication
- Collaboration
- Data Analysis
- Time Management
- System and IT Skills

Assessment: End Point Assessment after the training has been delivered – typically includes a portfolio, project and interview but this may vary.
