

Part A

The following criteria (experience, skills and qualifications) will be used to short-list at the application stage:

Essential

- Good knowledge of and ability to use legislation, standards, strategies and policies relative to transport planning.
- Good knowledge of and the ability to perform optioneering tasks.
- Good understanding of urban design and the principals of urbanism
- Good understanding and experience of implementing the principals of effective project management
- Ability to use Microsoft software packages.
- Good knowledge of effective public engagement and consultation exercises.
- Ability to build and maintain good working relationships with key stakeholders.
- Ability to analyse and assess complex information.
- Knowledge of CDM regulations and Health and Safety legislation

Desirable

- Post graduate qualification in planning/transport/transport planning/civil engineering
- Ability to use industry software such as GIS/AutoCAD

Part B

The following will be further explored at the interview stage:

- Understanding and/or experience of the principal of good project management
- Knowledge of relevant and immerging legislation/policies/strategies relating to transport
- Knowledge and/or experience of utilising industry standard software.

- Knowledge and/or experience in the principals of delivering public consultation end engagement exercises.
- Knowledge/experience of developing and maintaining relationships with Stakeholders and partner agencies
