## **Main Duties:**

The following is typical of the duties the post holder will be expected to perform. It is not necessarily exhaustive and other duties of a similar nature and level may be required.

#### **Core Essentials:**

- Relevant teaching qualifications
- Promote a safe and secure learning environment for all children, and ensure the schools' provision is inclusive at all levels.
- Lead by example and hold the highest expectations of professionalism and general conduct.
- Contribute to the strategic development, leadership and management of the school
- Lead appraisal of teachers and teaching assistant staff within their allocated key stage and facilitate appropriate training opportunities which will develop the skill set of support staff.
- Establish good relationships, encourage good working practices and support and lead teachers.
- Be a strong advocate for change and champion school improvement.
- To carry out the duties of a class teacher in accordance with the provision of the current School Teacher's Pay and Conditions document and within the range of Teacher's duties set out in that document.

## **Leader of Mathematics:**

 Ensure that the quality of teaching, learning and assessment in Mathematics throughout school is of the highest standard, enabling all children to develop in confidence, grow a love of mathematics whilst mastering skills and concepts.



- Support staff and leaders to identify strengths and gaps in learning and implement appropriate interventions.
- Convey a positive 'can do' attitude, motivate and inspire staff to secure successful outcomes in mathematics.
- To continually review the effectiveness of curriculum documentation to ensure that it meets the needs of all children.
- Provide training opportunities for all staff to develop in the teaching and learning of mathematics

## **Key Stage Lead:**

- Effectively lead a key stage, taking responsibility for the day to day provision, standards and expectations.
- Collate and analyse attainment and progress data from the key stage and use this information diagnostically to inform provision accordingly.
- Liaise with the Inclusion team and implement any actions required within their key stage, reviewing and reporting on impact and using this information to inform next steps.
- Liaise with subject leaders of the wider curriculum to implement any actions required within their key stage, reviewing and reporting on impact and using this information to inform next steps.
- To liaise with other key stage leaders to monitor and promote effective transition arrangements to ensure continuity and progression for all children from EYFS-KS1-KS2-Secondary school.
- Plan, organise and chair the key stage meetings as appropriate in order to ensure school policies and practices are implemented.
