Essential

- Relevant recent certified training/qualification specific to the provision of social care (minimum NVQ level 3 or equivalent) or equivalent experience
- Ability to prioritise and manage your own workload and the workload of others, ensuring high standards at all times
- Experience of leading or supervising a team
- Experience of service user assessment, and developing, implementing, monitoring and reviewing care plans
- Ability to identify other support requirements for service users and engage with health colleagues and other professionals within the wider health and social care system as appropriate
- Ability to recognise risks of harm and abuse and take action to deal with this
- Ability to challenge practice to keep individuals safe from harm
- Ability to promote, monitor and maintain health, safety and security in the working environment for both staff and service users
- Ability to deal with emergency situations appropriately
- Ability to identify and challenge practices, procedures, environments and behaviours which act as barriers in ways that respect diversity and difference
- Ability to move and handle service users and use specialist equipment according to set procedures
- Ability to communicate effectively with service users and carers and the ability to adapt own communication to meet needs of service users as required
- Ability to promote a positive customer experience
- Commitment to personal development
- Suitability to work with client group

- Ability to work effectively as part of a team
- Flexible approach to work, location, duties and hours including shift work and sleep-ins
- Ability to cope with change
- High level of motivation, commitment and enthusiasm to work with service user group
