The following criteria (experience, skills and qualifications) will be used to short-list at the application stage:

Essential

- Knowledge of current policies/legislation/guidance relating to the Environment (e.g. climate change, transport)
- Ability to effectively plan/organise actions, activities or events
- Ability to effectively prioritise workload whilst dealing with competing demands.
- Knowledge of Health and Safety regulations (including Risk Assessments and H&S Plans)
- On track to achieve a Batchelor or Master's degree (or equivalent) across either of the following: -
 - Civil Engineering
 - Planning/Transport Planning
 - Geography
 - Environmental Sciences
- Ability to communicate effectively with a wide and varied audience
- Ability to work as part of a team
- Ability to effectively utilise ICT systems and software (e.g. Microsoft packages)
- Ability to interpret information and solve varied problems associated with the delivery of Transport projects.

Desirable

• Knowledge of effective project management practices
