Job Purpose: To support the organisation's use of data through effective collection, management and modelling.

Main Duties: The following is typical of the duties the postholder will be expected to perform. It is not necessarily exhaustive and other duties of a similar nature and level may be required from time to time.

- 1. Engage with stakeholders to understand their questions, plans and issues and translate those into data requirements.
- 2. Working with colleagues across the council, develop and design solutions to capture, store and transform data through the ongoing cycle of initiation, deployment, and improvement.
- 3. Effective stakeholder engagement and relationship management including the communication of requirements and solutions in non-technical language to a range of stakeholders.
- 4. Produce appropriate documentation to enable the organisation to understand and utilise data assets, maintaining data quality and provenance.
- 5. Develop and maintain data architecture and pipelines to a high level of information governance, data standards and ICT Security.
- 6. Work alongside analysts to ensure data and metadata is extracted and transformed to enable meaning analysis and actionable insight.
- 7. Understand and apply different data models as appropriate and in response to the needs of the organisation and project.
- 8. Support researchers and service leads in linking and integrating data for analysis and service delivery.
