- Proven ability to meet with a range of clients, interpret their brief, produce feasibility reports, develop detailed design and specification, carry out contract administration duties and oversee works on a variety of projects.
- Ability to demonstrate organisational, planning and presentational skills.
- Evidence of effective written/oral communication skills and presentation skills involving a wide range of audiences
- Ability to motivate and positively influence people at all levels of the organisation
- Ability to influence and promote the importance of Health and Safety in relation to survey work.
