Motor Vehicle Technician Apprentice

Part A

The following criteria (experience, skills and qualifications) will be used to short-list at the application stage:

Essential:

- Clear motivation for undertaking an Apprenticeship in Motor Vehicle Craft Studies
- Level 2 qualifications in Maths & English (equivalent to a GCSE grade 4 / C or above) or the ability to achieve this determined through an assessment.
- Ability to work as part of a team to achieve shared outcomes.
- Good organisational skills and ability to prioritise work to meet deadlines.
- Ability to work in a workshop environment as well as outdoors as required.
- Ability to use IT systems

Desirable:

- Experience in a work environment, for example through a part time job, work placement, or voluntary work

Part B

The following criteria will be further explored at the interview stage:

- Communication skills, Problem Solving skills, Customer Service skills, Organisation skills.
- Commitment and enthusiasm to work in: Vehicle repair workshop and outdoors as required.
- Willing and able to undertake and learning and development required for an apprenticeship and to attend relevant training courses.
- General awareness and understanding of equal opportunities in the workplace.

Additional Requirements

- Two references from current and previous employers (or education establishment if applicant not in employment)
