Essential

1. Level 2 or 3 Award/Certificate in Supporting Teaching and Learning in schools or a Teaching Assistants qualification
2. Working knowledge of supporting children and young people in Key Stage 2, 3 or 4 within mainstream classrooms.
3. Working knowledge of the preparation and adaptation of activities, resources and equipment
4. Able to adapt learning activities under guidance from other specialist staff e.g. QTVI, Habilitation Specialist & VI Technical Support Officer.
5. Experience of supporting pupils with a range of special educational needs
6. Able to communicate effectively both verbally and in writing with teachers, children and young people.
7. Ability to develop good working relationships with children, families and professionals.
8. Ability to use IT effectively to maintain records and support learning
9. A positive attitude to disability issues/ equal opportunities

Desirable

1. Experience of working with children and young people with a visual impairment.
2. Working knowledge or awareness of Braille.
