Essential

1. Recognised Social Work Qualification, e.g., CQSW, CSS, DipSW, Degree in Social Work, or equivalent.
2. Knowledge and understanding of The Care Act and the Mental Capacity Act, with knowledge of current Safeguarding Policies and Procedures.
3. Knowledge of NHS Continuing Healthcare.
4. Experience of working in care management with adults.
5. Experience of assessing and addressing risk.
6. Awareness of the impact of ill health on quality of life and independence.
7. Able to summarise, analyse and evaluate complex information.
8. Time management skills with the ability to prioritise tasks.
9. Commitment to working in a multi-disciplinary, multi-agency way, liaising effectively with other agencies and professionals.
10. Effective assessment, planning and reviewing skills, working in partnership with service users, carers and service providers.
11. Excellent recording and report writing skills using electronic data information systems.

12. Able to contribute to, and work within, a supportive team environment.

2. Experience of using a strengths-based approach in practice.
3. Post qualifying experience within a community social work setting.
4. Knowledge of resources; health, local authority, voluntary and independent sector.
